The Foreman Art Gallery will usher in 2018 with a federative project that nods to the Mont-Mégantic International Dark Sky Reserve and regional astrophysics research. The exhibition *Parallax-e* probes the emergence of a new astronomical sublime informed by advances in optical and digital technologies, scientific projections and evolving aesthetic conventions.

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The round table will be a bilingual and cross-disciplinary event, setting an encounter between two French and two English speakers, two astrophysicists and two artists. The idea is to cover the spectrum of issues concerning visual culture in astronomy, as seen by astrophysicists and contemporary artists. The conversation will cover some concepts in astronomy, the role of technology, data visualization and aesthetics.

The roundtable will be co-mediated by Guillaume Poulin, scientific communicator at the Astrolab du Mont Mégantic and Gentiane Bélanger, director of the Foreman Art Gallery and curator of the *Parallax-e* exhibition. This event is organized in partnership with Sporobole Art Centre and the Astrolab du Mont-Mégantic.
